

WHERE DO ANIMALS LIVE?

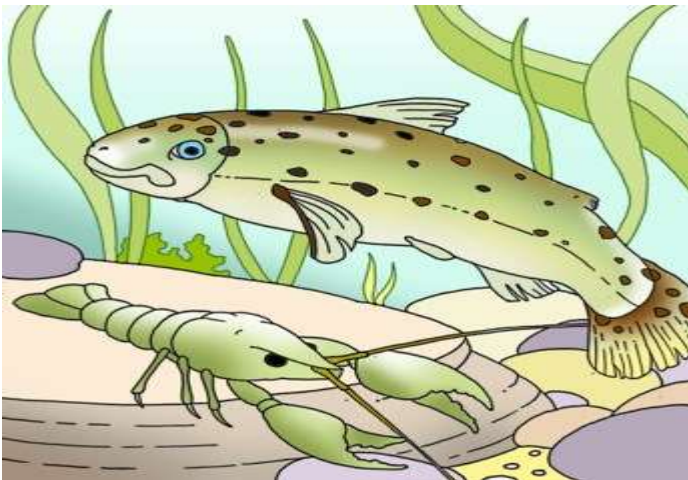
1- The sea.

In the sea there are **fish**, **algae** and **other organisms** adapted to live in **salt water**.



2- Rivers.

In rivers, there are **crabs**, **plants** and other organisms adapted to live in **moving water**.



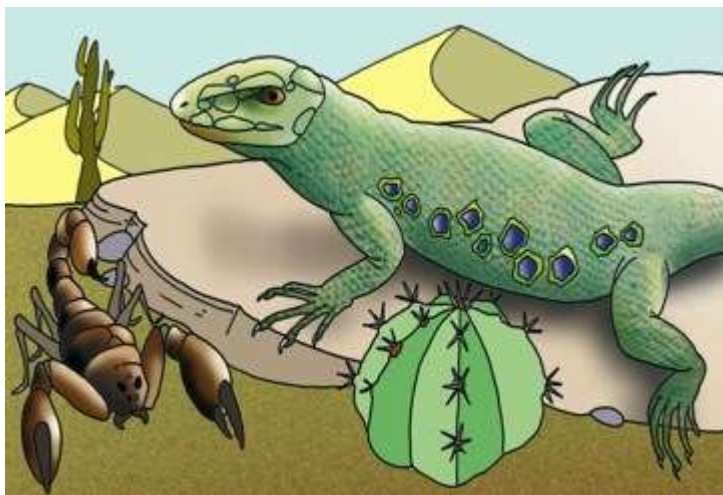
3- The poles.

At the poles, there are animals like **walrus** and **polar bears** adapted to survive even when it's **very cold**.



4- Deserts.

In deserts there are **lizards**, **scorpions**, **cactuses** and **other organisms** adapted to survive on **very little water**.



5- Towns.

Sparrows, **cats** and many **plants** live in our towns: they can survive **alongside people**.



6- Savannahs.

In savannahs it is **hot** and there is **little water**. **Plants** such as **acacias** and animals such as **lions** and **zebras** live here.



7- Jungles.

It's **hot** in jungles but it **rains a lot**. Enormous **plants** and **eye-catching animals** live here.



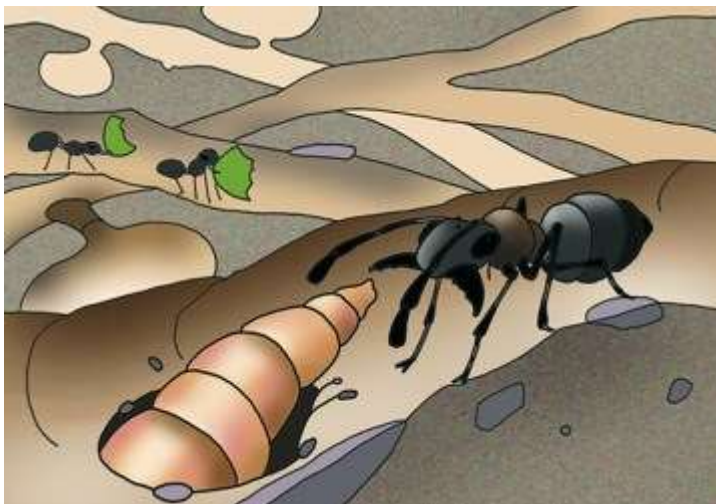
8- Mountains.

Mountains plants, eagles and **goats** are adapted to live in **high and cold places**.



9- Under the ground.

Worms, ants and **mole** live under the ground. The **roots** of plants **grow** here.
